Impact Area: Education

Significant Statistics: According to the 2014 Florida Department of Education Local Educational Agencies Profile, about 20% of school age students in the Escambia County School District have a disability. Many of these students have a diagnosis of or characteristics similar to Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD). Individualized ASD tailored teaching methods enable Capstone Academy to prepare preschool children with developmental disabilities and/or delays to enter the least restrictive setting when they transition from preschool to kindergarten.
