**Significant Statistics:** As of February 17, 2014, the Agency for Persons with Disabilities reports that 684 people in Escambia County and 22,000 statewide are on a waitlist for community-based disability services. The Essential Life Skills program keeps Escambia County residents with complex developmental disabilities from living in nursing homes and allows their families to work by providing a day program that engages adults and children in rewarding activities.
